



Code of Conduct

The Cayman Islands Football Association (CIFA) demands high standards in all aspects of the game.

CIFA requires that all members conduct themselves in a manner which reflects our commitment to encouraging fair play, building technical capacity, instilling positive values amongst all stakeholders, who serve as models of social development through sport, and serving as ambassadors for the Cayman Islands on and off the field.

Please play your part, and observe The Cayman Islands Football Association's Code of Conduct in everything you do.

On and off the field, I will:

- Show respect to others involved in the game including match officials, opposition players, coaches, managers, officials and spectators;
- Adhere to the Laws of the Game;
- Adhere to the spirit of the game;
- Promote Fair Play and high standards of behaviour;
- Always respect the match official's decision;
- Never enter the field of play without the referee's permission;
- Never engage in public criticism of the match officials;
- Never engage in public criticism of CIFA officials, staff, players; and
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour.

In general, I will:

- Never engage in or tolerate any form of bullying;
- Never use vulgar, racist, or abusive language;
- Develop mutual trust and respect with everyone to build their self-esteem;
- Refrain from participating in any illegal activities;
- Encourage my team members to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance;
- Co-operate fully with others in football (e.g. officials, doctors, physiotherapists, welfare officers) for each one's best interests.

I understand that if I do not follow this Code of Conduct, any or all of the following actions may be taken by the Cayman Islands Football Association, I could be:

- Required to leave the relevant program's activities;
- Required to meet with a CIFA relevant committee;
- Required to attend a CIFA education course;
- Suspended by CIFA from participating in any domestic competitions' matches and/or international activities;
- Fined by CIFA; and
- Suspended by CIFA from participating in any football activities.
